



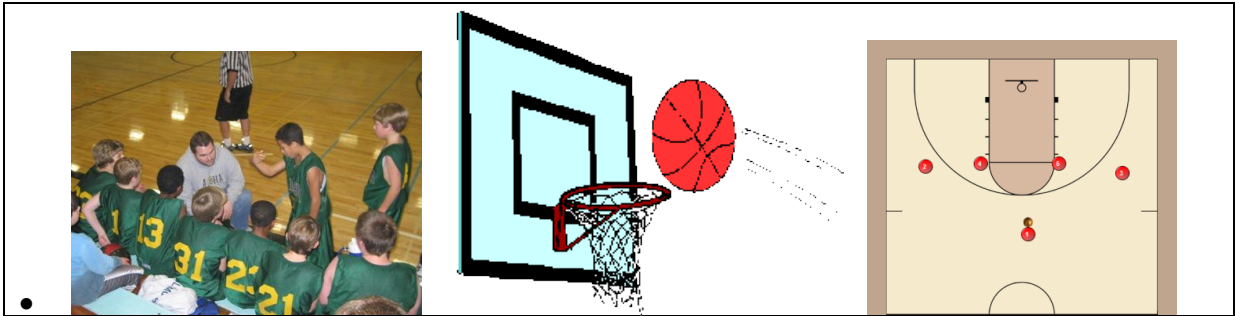
St. Thomas Aquinas Academy presents: 2nd Annual Grade School Basketball Coaching Clinic
