SUBJECT: COLORED VOLLEYBALL FOR YOUR MATCHES

It is our understanding that one of your players, **Rachel Williams** is color blind and has a difficult time seeing an all white volleyball. At our League meeting in May 2006 it was agreed by all schools that your team would be allowed to use a Colored VolleyLite ball for all of your 2006 League matches. If the host gym provides a colored volleylite ball, you would use the host gym's ball, however if the host gym did not have a colored volleylite ball, you will carry one with you and that ball would be used as the game ball for that match. This only applies to League matches, not tournaments as that is a decision each tournament director would have to make.

I will try to make the refs aware of this, however due to occasional last minute substitutions of refs who may not be well versed in the Parvkvew rule exceptions and just in case an opposing coach is not been made aware of this situation by their volleyball coordinator, I would suggest you carry a copy of this letter with you for presentation to anyone who may question you on this.
